Lower Intermediate level

Course organisation

• 8 x 2 hour sessions

This course is designed for people with a basic level competence in French.

Material for the course (photocopies, documents) will be circulated in class.

Number of participants: 8-16

This course is a self-standing course rather than part of an on-going programme.

Course objectives

To brush up and consolidate language skills needed to communicate efficiently during a trip to a French speaking country; to improve confidence and fluency in using the language.

By the end of this course, students should have consolidated their linguistic skills at the <u>Common European Framework of Reference of Reference for Languages</u>, level **A2**.

Course content

This course principally provides training in the listening, reading and speaking skills. A communicative approach will be used throughout the course, with an emphasis on communicating in everyday situations.

Topics covered may include:

Learning outcomes

On completion of this course, students should be able:

To understand instructions and explanations, short messages and announcements, the main points of a conversation.

To communicate efficiently in routine situations.
